## **I. GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Title:** 34<sup>th</sup> European Traditional Karate-Do Championship 2019  
**Sanctioned by:** World Traditional Karate-Do Federation (WTKF)  
**Tournament venue:** USC MGIMO Odintsovo, Moscow Region (Russia)

## **II. PARTICIPANTS**

All athletes that are selected by the respective WTKF National Federations to compete must fulfill the following conditions:

1. They must have the WTKF registered black belt (*Shodan* or higher) – registration number. This applies to all age categories: seniors, youth, juniors and cadets.
2. Age in agreement with their competition category.
3. They must know, fully understand and be able to compete in accordance with the WTKF competition rules.
4. They must be free of any physical or mental handicap that might cause a breach of the WTKF rules.
5. All KUMITE, KO-GO and FUKU-GO athletes are obliged to have mouth (tooth) guards (breast-protection for women, groin protector for men are optional, but recommended safety equipment).
6. They must have his/her own international traveling insurance and also personal accident insurance issued by their respective National Federations.
7. They must belong to a National Federation which is a full and paid-up member of the WTKF including the year 2019.
8. They must present Medical Release and International Health Insurance to Medical Emergencies.
9. All countries must bring two national flags.

## **V. APPLICATIONS & REGISTRATION**

### **A. Applications**

For the logistical reasons and for the proper development of 34<sup>th</sup> European Traditional Karate-Do Championship 2019 and **I** Amateur & **VI** Children's Traditional Karate-Do European Cup 2019 we ask all Federations to complete the registration of their: Official, Coach, Senseis, Judges, Athletes sending the application forms before **September 10, 2019**

**Note:** Any application submitted after this deadline will be processed, but additionally charged 10 euro per participant which will be paid to the Office of TOC when you register.

### **B. Participation Fees**

#### **34<sup>th</sup> European Traditional Karate-Do Championships 2019:**

**60 Euro** for athlete (only one fee, and athlete can participate in all competitions)

**50 Euro** for extra coaches

**20 Euro** courses of judges

In case of exams for judges (+ exams fees according to WTKF scale for the judges)

**20 Euro** sayonara party

Participation fees must be paid at the office of the TOC by **Thursday October 10, 2019**



## **VI. JUDGES**

1. **Selection of the Judges will be made by the WTKF Technical Committee Members during the WTKF Judges' Refresher Course held right before the European Championships on October 8-9, 2019 in Odintsovo (Russia).**
2. Judges participating in this event have to be WTKF Registered Qualified Judges (class A, B, C), who have participated in the Judges' Refresher Course and the exams procedure held before the tournament and completed the WTKF Judges' Refresher Course held in 2019.
3. All Judges must bring their own HAKAMA (black), whistle and clean KARATEGI including navy blue KARATEGI top.
